## Introduction

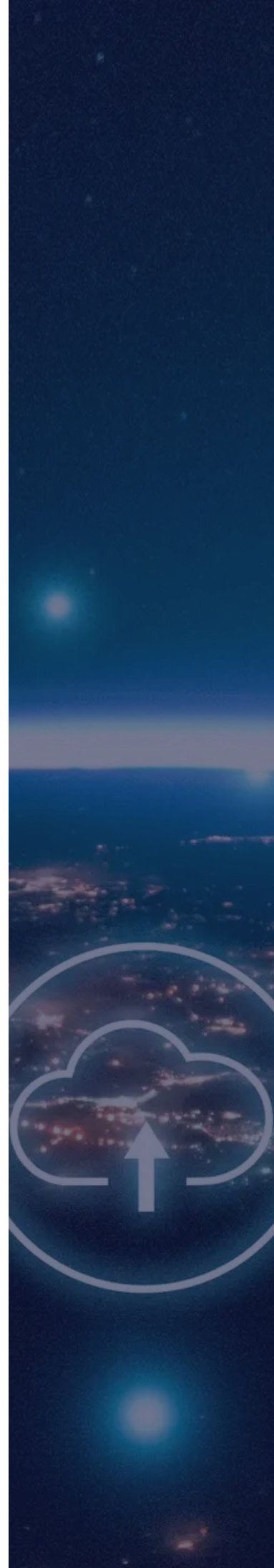

### Workflow and Nintex Limitations

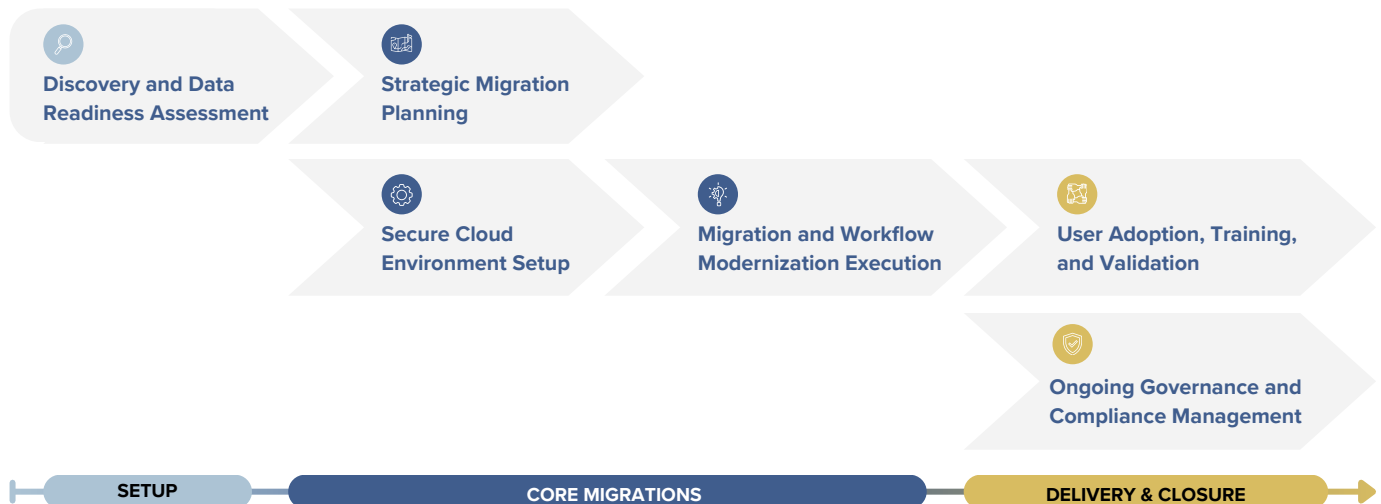
Transitioning from Nintex and other legacy workflow platforms to Power Platform introduces distinct issues:
